Seine River System Levels & Flows Declining

(Posted Friday, July 4, 2014)

The Raft Lake remains above the elevation prescribed in the Seine River Water Management Plan but lower than 415.500m. Inflows into the basin have been dissipating allowing the lake elevation to decline approximately 1 cm/day (0.4 inches/day). More than half of the dams outflow is being discharged over the weir while the remaining is passed through a sluice bay. The outflow at the Raft Lake dam remains below 150 m³/s and will continue to reduce as the elevation decreases.

Log operations to reduce outflows have been conducted at Calm Lake Generating Station and Sturgeon Falls Generating Station over the past few days. H2O Power anticipates additional flow reductions in the near future. The forebay elevation at these stations may rise slightly but will remain within its normal operating range.

Although circumstances remain outside normal conditions, all users should continue to exercise caution and due care at all times when accessing and using the Seine River.
